Summary of Position:

The Security Officer/Maintenance-Family Enhancement provides maintenance and janitorial services for the camp facilities and grounds, ensuring staff and clients have a clean and tidy working environment, as well as maintain a safe and secure environment for staff and clients by patrolling and monitoring the premises and personnel. The incumbent is expected to have skills, training, and knowledge of community resources on land and waterways as well as have experience on how to navigate through the resource area and to have Bear Guard and/or related training. The Security Officer/Maintenance must have training and experience in the operation of motorboats, skidoo's, ATVs, and harvesting equipment/tools. The incumbent is to take initiative and demonstrate good judgement in determining priorities, methods, and action to be taken on matters related to the camp facilities and grounds cleanliness and safety.

- High school diploma or equivalent preferred.
- 1-year related experience in cleaning/maintenance and/or security preferred.
- Effective time management skills.
- Attention to detail.
- Ability to speak Cree/Dene an asset.
- Knowledge and experience working on the land and waterways.
